What is the Science Club? The SSA+S Science Club was organized to provide opportunities for students to have fun and explore science. Our Science Club consists of members in all grade levels.

What do you do each month? Our focus during the first half of the year is helping students with their Science Fair projects. We meet every Wednesday (September through November), from **4:30 -5:15 pm**. Students should bring a drink and snack with them. , We meet in Mrs. Watson's room 214. Especially welcome are our returning Science Club members because they help as mentors and coaches on Science Fair projects.
