

SSA+S Dress Code

SSA+S enforces a strict dress code to assist with providing a safe and orderly environment.

All uniform pieces are listed below and must be purchased at Children's World Uniform Supply. Students on Free/Reduced Lunch can request a uniform voucher at the Used Uniform Sale with appropriate documentation.

Shirt - Polo-style shirts embroidered with the school logo in solid red, grey, or black.

Shorts/Pants/Skirts - The only acceptable bottoms are the SSA+S uniform bottoms with a red paw print, which are sold only at Children's World.

Sweatshirt - School hoodies and zipper sweatshirts may only be purchased at Children's World. During extreme cold weather, a coat/jacket may be worn to school, but must be kept in locker during the school day. Solid-colored undershirts/sweatshirts are permitted under polos on cold weather days.

Physical Education Uniform - The entire physical education uniform, except for dance attire, must be purchased at Children's World and will be worn by the student during PE class, or the student will receive a zero for that day.

Backpacks - One clear or mesh, single-compartment backpack with student ID displayed is the only backpack option.

Footwear - Students must wear sneakers or flat heeled dress shoes or boots. All footwear must be closed at the toes and heel, and both shoes must match. Sandals, slippers, Crocs, or heeled shoes are not acceptable for safety reasons.

Spirit Days: Spirit Days are normally scheduled on the last day of the school week.

- This event allows children to wear appropriate jeans with a school spirit shirt.
- Jeans must be one solid color. No prints/patterns please.
- Jeans may not have rips or holes above the knee - this includes factory alterations.
- Excessively tight or fitted clothing may not be worn. "Jeggings", "leggings" and spandex materials are not allowed. Please note- oversized or low riding pants are also not permitted.
